During the renewal inspection on 5/11/2022, I found 3 *violations*. The violations are listed below and explained in the attached report:

R 400.8125 Staff; volunteer; requirements.  
R 400.8131 Professional Developments requirements.  
R 400.8345 Water supply; plumbing.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 7/19/2022. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.

- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

**IF INFANT SAFE SLEEP VIOLATIONS**

Due to the infant safe sleep violation(s), all of your infant caregivers must take training on infant safe sleep. This must be included in your corrective action plan. In addition, a follow up inspection may be made to check compliance with the infant safe sleep rules.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, a regular license will be issued. You will receive it in the mail.

**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.8125                    Staff; volunteer; requirements.**

(1) All staff and volunteers shall provide appropriate care and supervision of children at all times.

During the inspection in the Fellowship Hall, I observed a Child Care Staff Member leave a child alone sleeping in a high chair while she took the rest of the group of children to the bathroom located outside the Fellowship Hall.

**R 400.8131                    Professional development requirements.**

(12) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 month of the notice.

During a review of the records I found six staff members had not taken the Health and Safety refresher training for 2021.

**R 400.8345                    Water supply; plumbing.**

(4) All plumbing fixtures and water and waste pipes must be properly installed and maintained in good working condition.

I observed that two toilet seats in the girls' bathroom were loose.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend the license be renewed.
