The licensee has requested a change in use space, programming and age range to add a Great Start to Readiness Preschool (GSRP) classroom.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Kment Elementary is a public elementary school owned and operated by Roseville Community Schools.

The following rooms were previously approved for child care use:

The cafeteria measures 41 feet by 68 feet for a total of 2788 square feet of usable child care space. The room capacity is 80 children over 4 years of age.

The gymnasium measure 55 feet by 78 feet for a total of 4290 square feet of usable child care space. The room capacity is 123 children over 4 years of age.

The licensee has requested approval of the following room for the GSRP program:

Room 307 measures 38 feet by 25 feet for a total of 950 square feet of usable child care space. The room capacity is 27 children over 4 years of age. The licensee has requested a room capacity of 16 children to align with GSRP standards.

The licensee has requested that the center capacity remain at 120 children ages 4 years to 12 years.

The licensee has submitted an updated equipment inventory for the GSRP classroom. There is an adequate and varied supply of developmentally appropriate equipment and furniture for the new GSRP classroom and the center's overall capacity of 120.

There are eight toilets, four urinals and six sinks in the immediate vicinity of the gymnasium and cafeteria. There is one toilet and one sink located in the preschool classroom and an additional four toilets, two urinals and four sinks located within close proximity to the preschool classroom. The toilets and sinks are sufficient for the requested capacity of 120.

The licensee has provided documentation that the building was built after 1978. Therefore, a lead hazard risk assessment was not required.

An environmental health inspection was conducted at the time of original issuance. The new classroom is similar to rooms previously inspected by the health department; therefore, a new environmental health inspection was not required.

On 09/06/2018, a playground safety inspection was conducted by a certified public playground inspector. The playground was in compliance with the 2010 Edition of the Playground for Public Safety Handbook. However, much of the equipment has not been approved for children under 5 years of age. Children in the GSRP program will not use the playground equipment. A large grassy area of the playground has been designated for use for preschoolers.

TERMS:

The program will offer a GSRP preschool program and school age child care.

The school age program operates Monday through Friday from 6:30a.m. to 6:00p.m. A morning and afternoon session are offered as well as child care on half days.

The GSRP program operates Monday through Thursday from 8:55a.m. to 3:45p.m. Before and after school care is not currently offered.

Both programs follow Roseville Community School for closings and holidays.

The center offers a morning and afternoon snack to children in attendance during the school age program.


The GSRP program provides breakfast, lunch and an afternoon snack to preschool children in attendance.

Swimming and transportation are not provided.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval of the following:

- The addition of a preschool component for the GSRP classroom.
- The change in use space to include room 307.
- The change in age range to include children ages 4 -12 years of age.
