- R 400.8340 (3) Food services and nutrition; provided by parents.**

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 9/30/2023. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.

- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.


Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, a regular license will be issued. You will receive it in the mail.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:	
R 400.8125	Staff; volunteer; requirements.
	(3) All supervised volunteers shall receive a public sex offender registry (PSOR) clearance before having any contact with a child in care. A copy of this clearance must be kept on file at the center.
During the onsite inspection and review of the records, I observed that the licensee designee did not complete a PSOR clearance as required.	
R 400.8125	Staff; volunteer; requirements.
	(5) A written statement must be signed and dated by staff and volunteers at the time of hiring or before volunteering indicating all of the following information: (a) The individual is aware that abuse and neglect of children is against the law. (b) The individual has been informed of the center's policies on child abuse and neglect. (c) The individual knows that all staff and volunteers are required by law to immediately report suspected abuse and neglect to children's protective services.
I observed during the onsite inspection and review of the records that the volunteer staff did not have a signed written statement of the above requirement.	
R 400.8128	Staff; volunteer; tuberculosis.
	A center shall keep on file at the center evidence to verify that each child care staff member and each volunteer who has contact with children at least 4 hours per week for more than 2 consecutive weeks is free from communicable tuberculosis (TB). Verification of TB status is required within 1 year before employment or volunteering.
I observed during the onsite inspection and review of the records, that volunteer staff did not have communicable tuberculosis per the above requirement.	
R 400.8134	Hand washing.
	(2) Staff and volunteers shall ensure that children wash their hands at all of the following times: (e) After each diapering.

During the onsite inspection, I observed that volunteer staff did not wash her hands after diapering child.	
R 400.8185	Primary care.
	(5) Primary caregiving assignments must be documented and provided to parents.
I observed during the onsite inspection that primary caregiving assignment was not documented and provided to parents.	
R 400.8340	Food services and nutrition; provided by parents.
	(2) Breast milk, formula, milk, or other beverages provided in a same-day supply must be furnished daily in either of the following: (a) Clean, sanitary, ready-to-feed bottles or beverage containers.
I observed during the onsite inspection that the infant bottles were not ready to feed, powder formula and water sent by parent was used by staff to prepare bottle.	
R 400.8340	Food services and nutrition; provided by parents.
	(3) Breast milk, formula, milk, other beverages, and food furnished in a same-day supply must be covered and labeled with the child's first and last name and the date.
I observed during the onsite inspection that the infant's bottle did not have child's first and last name and date as required.	

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
