You gave us an acceptable written corrective action plan. We will send you a regular license in the mail.



III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:	
R 400.8128	Staff; volunteer; tuberculosis.
	A center shall keep on file at the center evidence to verify that each child care staff member and each volunteer who has contact with children at least 4 hours per week for more than 2 consecutive weeks is free from communicable tuberculosis (TB). Verification of TB status is required within 1 year before employment or volunteering.
I observed during the onsite inspection and review of the records that Ms. Tabitha Long, child care staff member did not have on file that she was free from communicable tuberculosis.	
R 400.8131	Professional development requirements.
	(3) Before caring for children, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall be trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.
I observed during the onsite inspection and review of the records, I observed that Ms. Daniela Ferguson and Hayley Monette, child care staff members did not have the above required training.	
R 400.8131	Professional development requirements.
	(4) Before unsupervised contact with children, all child care staff members who work directly with children shall complete prevention and control of infectious disease training, including immunizations.
I observed during the onsite inspection and review of the records that Ms. Daniela Ferguson and Hayley Monette, child care staff members did not complete training in prevention and control of infectious disease and immunizations.	
R 400.8131	Professional development requirements.
	(5) Within 90 days of being hired, or the first day as an unsupervised volunteer, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall complete the following trainings, which may count toward

<p>I observed during the onsite inspection and review of the records that Ms. Tabitha Long, child care staff member did not complete Health and Safety Course part two as required.</p>	
R 400.8152	Medication; administrative procedures.
	(3) All medication must be in its original container, stored according to instructions, and clearly labeled for a named child, including all nonprescription topical medications described in subrule (8) of this rule.
<p>I observed during the onsite inspection that Child A's Benadryl medication was not labeled with Child A's name.</p>	
R 400.8340	Food services and nutrition; provided by parents.
	(3) Breast milk, formula, milk, other beverages, and food furnished in a same-day supply must be covered and labeled with the child's first and last name and the date.
<p>I observed during the onsite inspection that 2 out of 4 of the children's bottles were not labeled with the child's first and last name and date.</p>	
R 400.8525	Exits.
	(4) Exit doors and all doors in the means of egress shall be side-hinged and equipped with knob, lever-type, non-locking-against-egress, or panic-type hardware.

During the onsite inspection, I observed that the rooms had gates at the entrance of the rooms with locking against egress hardware.

Lead caregiver; qualifications; responsibilities.

(5) Lead caregivers shall meet 1 of the following qualifications in Table 3.

During the onsite inspection and review of the records, I observed that Ms. Melanie Hamama, child care staff member did not have lead caregiver qualifications

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 07/14/2021. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
