III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Description of Facility

The facility is located within the Center Line Preparatory Academy on a residential street in Centerline.

Approved space (room numbers, sizes, capacity and ages of children for which each room/well-defined space is approved, etc.):

The following rooms have been approved as program specific child care space:

Room 103 is 32 feet x 20 feet, providing a total of 640 square feet of useable space. This accommodates a capacity of 18 children ages 2 ½ years and older.

Room 104 is 31 feet x 21 feet, providing a total of 651 square feet of useable space. This accommodates a capacity of 19 children ages 2 ½ years and older.

Room 105 is 31 feet x 21 feet, providing a total of 651 square feet of useable space. This accommodates a capacity of 19 children ages 2 ½ years and older.

The above approved rooms provide a total center capacity of 56 children.

The following rooms have been approved as non-program specific child care space:

Room 106 is 30 feet x 21 feet, providing a total of 630 square feet of useable space. This accommodates a capacity of 18 children ages 2 ½ years and older.

Room 107 is 30 feet x 21 feet, providing a total of 630 square feet of useable space. This accommodates a capacity of 18 children ages 2 ½ years and older.

Room 108 is 30 feet x 21 feet, providing a total of 630 square feet of useable space. This accommodates a capacity of 18 children ages 2 ½ years and older.

Room 109 is 30 feet x 21 feet, providing a total of 630 square feet of useable space. This accommodates a capacity of 18 children ages 2 ½ years and older.

Room 110 is 30 feet x 21 feet, providing a total of 630 square feet of useable space. This accommodates a capacity of 18 children ages 2 ½ years and older.

Room 111 is 30 feet x 21 feet, providing a total of 630 square feet of useable space. This accommodates a capacity of 18 children ages 2 ½ years and older.

Room 1112 is 30 feet x 21 feet, providing a total of 630 square feet of useable space. This accommodates a capacity of 18 children ages 2 ½ years and older.

Room 113 is 30 feet x 21 feet, providing a total of 630 square feet of useable space. This accommodates a capacity of 18 children ages 2 ½ years and older.

Equipment: During the inspection I was provided an equipment list documenting the required number of toys, activities, appropriately sized furniture for a capacity of 56 children.

I observed during the inspection an appropriate number of toys for imaginative and creative play, puzzles, books and other table top activities for quiet play, appropriately sized furniture for the different development stages of school aged children.

Activities will be provided as enrichment experiences in the areas of reading, science, and math.

Number of sinks and toilets:

The hallway that all approved rooms exit in to has two bathrooms.

The girl's bathroom has 9 toilets and 4 sinks.

The boy's bathroom has 4 toilets, 9 urinals and 4 sinks.

Room 103 has 1 sink.

This is a total of 13 toilets, 9 urinals and 9 sinks. This supports a capacity of 56 children.

Outdoor play area - location, fenced or not, water hazards:

The large, fenced outdoor play area exceeds the required 1200 square feet of useable space. The area is located on the west side across the parking lot of the building. There are no water hazards on the premises.

Documentation if a lead hazard risk assessment was required and the results:

A lead hazard risk assessment was not required.

Documentation of playground safety: The play ground does not have any play structures that require a play ground safety inspection.

B. Program Description

The program is a before and after school child care.

Ages of children served: The program accepts children ages 5 years-old through 12 years-old.

Proposed days and hours of operation: The program operates Monday through Friday 6:30AM to 7PM.

Full or part time (AM or PM sessions or both): The program will provide a morning program from 6:30AM to 8AM and an afternoon program from 3PM to 7PM.

Other program components - transportation, swimming, food service: The program does not offer transportation, swimming, or food service.

Name of program director and under what rules the program director is qualified:

The approved program director is Donna Mobley. Ms. Mobley qualifies under Licensing Rule 400.8113 (8)(g) and (9).

Is there a central administrator that meets the administrative requirement?

There is no central administrator.

Explanation of variance(s), if any:

There are no variances.

C. Rule/Statutory Violations

There are no rule or statutory violations.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend the facility be opened to an original license.
