II. Purpose of Addendum

The license has requested approval of a Great Start to Readiness Preschool program and an increase in capacity to accommodate the program.

III. Methodology

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Little Conqueror's Daycare is located in a stand alone building in Roseville. It is comprised of a large child care room that is divided into two classrooms and the Great Room.

The Toddler A side of the child care room measures 19.5 feet x 24.8 feet and 19 feet x 8.2 feet, providing a total of 639 square feet. This accommodates the requested capacity of 12 children 18 months through 30 months.

The Toddler B side of the child care room measures 24.8 feet x 18 feet, providing a total of 446 square feet. This accommodates the requested capacity of 13 children over 30 months of age. The licensee is aware that when there are mixed ages in the room, the ratio is based on the ratio requirements of the youngest child present.

A portion of the Great Room has been sectioned off for the new GSRP classroom. The area measures 19.6 feet by 11 feet and 30 feet by 17 feet for a total of 725.6 square feet. This accommodates a capacity of 21 children ages 4 years through 12 years. The licensee has requested a room capacity of 18 children to align with GSRP standards.

The GSRP classroom will be used for school age child care during the summer months. The previously approved space for school age child care is no longer in use and not approved at this time.

The classrooms are furnished with a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment. The licensee has submitted an updated equipment inventory for the GSRP classroom. There is an adequate amount of equipment to support the GSRP room capacity of 18 children and overall center capacity of 43.

There are total of 5 hand washing sinks, 5 toilets, and 2 urinals located throughout the center. This supports the center's capacity of 43.

There is a grassy, fenced in area located on the south side of the building that will be used for outdoor play. There are no water hazards on or adjacent to the property.

TERMS:

The center will provide care to children ages 18 months to 12 years of age.


The hours of operation are Monday through Friday from 6:00a.m. to 6:00p.m. The GSRP classroom operates Monday through Thursday from 8:30a.m. to 3:30p.m. Before and after school care is available for children in the GSRP program, including Fridays. School age programming is available during the summer. The center will operate year-round

The center will provide breakfast, lunch and an afternoon snack to children in attendance. Lunch will be catered through an establishment with a valid food service license until which time the center is approved to prepare food onsite.

Transportation and swimming are not offered.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval of the new space in the Great Room for the new GSRP classroom. I also recommend approval of an increase in capacity from 38 to 43 children ages 18 months to 12 years of age.
