R 400.8188 (14) Sleeping, resting, and supervision.	During the onsite inspection, children were napping and the rooms	Lamps have been placed inside of the classrooms to ensure sufficient lighting.	08/03/2022



R400.8840(6) Swimming activity area.	Two inflatable wading pools were added to the outdoor play area. One wading pool was emptied, but the other wading pool had not been completely emptied and had dirty, standing water.	Wading pools will not be used and have been removed.	08/03/2022

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
