III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records. Children’s records and programming were not observed at the time of this inspection as the center has not operated this year.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8305

Plan review; approval; inspections.

(2) An inspection must be conducted by the local health department, and an approval granted indicating compliance with all of the rules in this part, except R 400.8330, 400.8335, and 400.8340, at all of the following times:

(c) Every 2 years, at the time of renewal, if the center provides food service where the food is prepared and served on-site, unless the kitchen is currently licensed to provide food service.

Ms. Blumenschein did not ensure that an environmental health inspection was completed every 2 years at the time of renewal. The environmental health inspection was completed, but the report has not been received at the time of this inspection.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an A rated environmental health inspection, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
