II. Purpose of Addendum

The licensee requests to have a school-age summer program for 36 children.

III. Methodology

1/4/2023 Modification request - summer program for school-age children.
1/19/2023 File review.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the license have been modified on 2/14/2018, 8/15/2019, 1/10/2020, 5/28/2020, 10/12/2020, 01/11/2022, and 01/19/2023.

The first-floor rooms 108 and 110 are combined into a single large space measuring 44' by 28.5' for a total of 1,254 square feet. This accommodates the requested capacity of 36 children over the age of 30 months. Group size limits for age 30 months to 3 years is 16. Appropriate group size limits in well-defined spaces and ratios will be followed in this room.

The second-floor rooms are described below: Room 201 is 21 ft. x 31 ft. for a total of 651 square feet. This accommodates the requested capacity of 12 children under the age of 30 months. Room 205 is 21 ft. x 31 ft. for a total of 651 square feet. This room is added and approved with this modification to provide care for the requested capacity of 12 children under the age of 30 months. Room 206 is 21 ft. x 26 ft. for a total of 546 square feet. This accommodates the requested capacity of 11 children per room under the age of 30 months. Room 208 is 21 ft. x 26 ft. for a total of 546 square feet. This accommodates the requested capacity of 11 children under the age of 30 months.

The third-floor rooms are described below: Room 302 is 21 ft. x 21 ft. for a total of 441 square feet. This accommodates the requested capacity of 13 children over the age of 30 months. Room 303 and 305 are combined into a single large space of 21 ft. x 42 ft. for a total of 882 square feet. This accommodates the requested capacity of 25 children over the age of 30 months. Room 306 is 21 ft. x 20 ft. for a total of 420 square feet. This accommodates the requested capacity of 12 children over the age of 30 months. Room 307 is 21 ft. x 22 ft. for a total of 462 square feet. This accommodates the requested capacity of 13 children over the age of 30 months. Rooms 308 and 310 are combined into single large space of 21 ft. x 38 ft. for a total of 798 feet. This accommodates the requested capacity of 23 children over the age of 30 months.

There are 13 toilets and 25 sinks in the center. These facilities support the requested capacity of 168 children.

The classrooms are furnished with an adequate amount of developmentally appropriate equipment.

Due to special investigation findings from August 2021, child care licensing requested that the licensee no longer provide care for school-age children during the summer. The licensee agreed and provided a Request for Modification on January 4, 2022, requesting removal of the summer school-age program as a program component.

The program currently provides care to school-age children during the school year. The center previously had school-age children in a summer program. A corrective action plan was completed in January 2022. The capacity of school age children will be 36 for the summer program, and there should not be repeat violations.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that the terms of the license be modified to include care of school age children during the summer months.
