III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the inspection, I observed infants and toddlers receiving nurturing and individualized care. Children were resting and preschoolers who did not rest had quiet activities available. The center is extremely clean, well-organized and maintained, and has high-quality equipment.

Professional development activities have increased and multiple staff members are seeking their Child Development Associate (CDA) certification.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
