Dear Ms. Sandstrom:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 09/12/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8380 Maintenance of premises.

(1) The premises must be maintained in a clean and safe condition and must not pose a threat to health or safety.

The bathroom near the back exit has exposed long, wrapped wires to the right of the handwashing sink. Children use this bathroom and these wires next to the sink pose a hazard.

R 400.8380 Maintenance of premises.

(4) Floors, interior walls, and ceilings must be kept in sound condition, good repair, and maintained in a clean condition.

The laminate-type floor in the back classroom has exposed glue and a missing section. This room did flood in the spring.

During the inspection, I observed children engaged in developmentally appropriate choice/work time. The child care staff members were actively promoting children's educational activities.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 10/14/2023. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.
