Dear Ms. Trucks:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 05/16/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

At the time of the onsite inspection, both classrooms of children were in the outdoor play area together. I observed five child care staff members with twenty-nine children. Different activities had been set up for children as an end-of-the-year celebration, as well as making homemade shaved ice. Staff were spread throughout the play area providing appropriate supervision, and all interactions seen were positive.

As a result of the inspection, I did not find any rule or law violations.

During the exit conference, technical assistance/consultation was provided regarding the following:

- As a reminder, new staff do not take the refresher training in the same calendar year that they take Module 1 and Module 2.
- I reminded Ms. Fuentes that all pages of the consent and disclosure packet must be located in the staff member's file, with the possible exception of the last page.
- The sink in Room 2 did not have hand washing procedures posted next to it. Ms. Fuentes will print new procedures immediately.
- I talked with Ms. Fuentes about creating specific emergency procedures for children with special needs or chronic medical conditions in the future, with examples.

- As children were playing outside prior to eating and there was not a hand washing sink available, I suggested that children at least sanitize their hands prior to eating their shaved ice. It should be noted that they were using bowls and spoons.


