## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection, I observed three sections of preschool and two sections of preschool-aged child care. I observed children departing from preschool and arriving at child care. I observed small group activities such as writing, crafts, and playdough, choice time, circle time with singing and movement, and free play. I also observed outdoor play, toileting, hand washing, and lunch. In all aspects of the

day, staff had positive interactions with children and provided appropriate care and supervision.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the exit conference, technical assistance/consultation was provided regarding the following:

- I reminded Ms. Taylor and Ms. Smith that the center must have a policy for the exclusion of staff and volunteers due to illness. This may be the same as the current policy for children.
- I praised Ms. Taylor and Ms. Smith for their individualized emergency procedures for children with special needs and/or chronic medical conditions.
- I reminded Ms. Taylor and Ms. Smith that fire drills must be conducted as least quarterly, regardless of the schedule published by the local school district.
- I requested that a copy of each staff member's emergency form be placed in their staff binder.
- I requested that the verbiage of R 400.8125 (5) be included on the staff signature page.
- I reviewed with Ms. Taylor and Ms. Smith the circumstances under which a newly hired employee may not need to have an updated TB test.
- I informed Ms. Taylor and Ms. Smith of the option for a lead caregiver variance if the need should arise in the future.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an "A" rated fire safety inspection, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
