III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection, there were 15 children present with 2 child care staff members. A third child care staff member came into the classroom during the inspection. I observed small motor activities at stations, bathroom procedures, small group activities, large motor activities, as well as sanitizing classroom tables. At the end of my inspection the children were resting. Staff members provided appropriate supervision.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the exit conference, I provided technical assistance/consultation on the following:

- I provided an updated recall list.
- I provided guidance on including a medical plan for any allergies identified by parents.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
