R 400.8125(1)	Child care staff members did not provide appropriate care and supervision when Child A was bit repeatedly.	Staff members inside the classrooms are to shadow the children that are known to bite more often than others. They are to use redirection with table toys and other sensory items such as teething toys when the child(ren) are having a more difficult time. We will also follow the biting protocol and policies that the facility has in store.	4/17/24
R 400.8112(2)(e)	Alexandria Blanzly did not ensure that her center's CCBC account was accurate, with all child care staff members connected.	I have been doing checks every two weeks, or when a new employee has started, to ensure that staff	4/17/24

	LC1 worked at the center for approximately nine months without being connected.	members are connected and do not need renewed fingerprints.	
R 400.8112(1)(c)	The center's program director did not ensure that LC1 was eligible to be a child care staff member prior to LC1 having unsupervised contact with children.	I have been doing check-ins every two weeks to ensure that all staff members are connected and do not need renewal of their finger prints. I also compare it to my staffing plan as well, so I can ensure that I do not miss anyone. The hiring process has become more accurate with scheduling their fingerprinting on the spot so that their is no long wait to get them started in the center.	4/17/24
R 400.8140(1)	CCSM did not utilize appropriate methods of discipline when threatening to get Alexandria Blanzzy to handle her related child's misbehavior, after telling the child that Alexandria Blanzzy would spank her.	We have created an employee form that needs to be filled out and signed by all employees at the time of hire, along with any employees that are currently employed, that states they will treat related children children the same as the child care facility children. There will be no more special treatment or inappropriate methods of discipline.	4/17/24
R 400.8345(1)	The center was utilizing drinking water sources that were not approved by the local health department.	We have purchased water pitchers for each room to fill up in the mornings from the kitchen sink before the openers shift starts. If	4/17/24


		they run low or run out of water throughout the day, they are instructed to ask for coverage or do it during their lunch or breaks.	
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It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
