III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Description of Facility

Approved space (room numbers, sizes, capacity and ages of children for which each room/well-defined space is approved, etc.):

This child care facility is located in the North Central Elementary school.

Room 108 measures 26 ft. x 29 ft. for a total of 754 sq. ft. This allows for a capacity of 21 children ages 2.5 to 12 years.

Room 109 measures 26 ft. x 29 ft. for a total of 754 sq. ft. This allows for a capacity of 21 children ages 2.5 to 12 years.

Total capacity for this child care center is 42 children ages 2.5 to 12 years.

Equipment: There is a wide variety of developmentally appropriate equipment and activities for the stated age-range and capacity.

Number of sinks and toilets: Each room has one toilet and two sinks with an additional four toilets and two sinks located within 50 feet of the classrooms. There is a total of six toilets and four sinks which supports the capacity of this child care center.

Outdoor play area - location, fenced or not, water hazards: The outdoor play area is located next to the building. It is not fenced and there are no water hazards.

Documentation if a lead hazard risk assessment was required and the results:

A lead risk hazard assessment is not required as the wing the child care center is located in was built in 1989. The children will utilize the school wing only that was built

in 1989 and the licensee has submitted a written statement that this is the only space enrolled children will utilize.

Documentation of playground safety: There was no playground equipment at the time of this inspection.

B. Program Description

Ages of children served: The child care will serve children ages 2.5 to 12 years.

Proposed days and hours of operation: The program will be in operation 6:00am to 6:00pm Monday through Friday throughout the school year.

Full or part time (AM or PM sessions or both): The program will run full time with a before and after school component.

Other program components – Food service: morning and afternoon snacks are provided as well as lunch.

Name of program director and under what rules the program director is qualified:
The program director is Danielle Chartier. She qualifies under R 400.8113(7)(d)(9).

Is there a central administrator that meets the administrative requirement?
There is no central administrator at this time.

Explanation of variance(s), if any: There are no variances at this time.

C. Rule/Statutory Violations

This facility was in full compliance at the time of the inspection.

IV. RECOMMENDATION
