

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS


This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the on-site inspection, I observed children arriving to the after-school program. I observed proper handwashing techniques being utilized before snack time. I observed children engaged in fine motor activities including drawing, coloring, and homework. I observed literacy activities. I observed caregivers, parents, and children during pick up time. Caregiver interactions with children were positive and nurturing. Staff and child records were organized and readily available.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
