## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection I observed large circle time with literacy supportive activities. I observed children transition between activities. I observed handwashing and lunch. I observed sanitizing and preparation for a variety of activities. I observed outdoor play. I observed children napping, resting, and engaging in quiet activities. I observed child care staff members to manage undesirable behavior with patience and creativity. Children were engaged with staff and are in an established routine. Records were readily available and organized.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center with a capacity of 40.
