

## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS



Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, I observed the children to be engaged in free play, art, feeding, rest time, and planned activities. The caregiving staff were engaged with the children and the activities were developmentally appropriate.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.
