This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 06/16/2021. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

During my onsite visit, the children were engaged in outdoor play and painting.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8143 Children's records.

(8) Upon enrollment and annually thereafter, a center shall obtain and keep on file at the center a signed statement from a school-age child's parent confirming all of the following:

(a) The child is in good health with activity restrictions noted.

(b) The child's immunizations are up-to-date.

(c) The immunization record or appropriate waiver is on file with the child's school.

I reviewed 10 children's files. There was no verification of a signed statement from a parent that confirmed the following: the child is in good health with activities

restrictions noted; the child's immunizations are up to date, and the immunization record or appropriate waiver is on file with the child's school.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 07/06/21. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.
