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II. Purpose of Addendum

The program director requested an increase in capacity for room 203 to increase from six infants to eight infants. A change in overall age range was also requested to change from six weeks to five years to birth to age six years.

III. Methodology

12/07/2022 Contact document received – Email from program director regarding a potential modification to the infant room.

12/07/2022 Contact document sent – Responded to email regarding modification.

12/15/2022 Onsite Inspection Completed – M. Smith and T. Allard conducted onsite to complete modification.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

A. Description of Facility Midland County ESA-Longview Early Childhood Center is located in the city of Midland, east of town just off Bay City Road. It will offer care for infants up to preschool age. They will utilize four classrooms in the building along with periodic use of the gym for large motor activities and weather permitting.

Approved space (room numbers, sizes, capacity and ages of children for which each room/well-defined space is approved, etc.): Rooms approved in this building include Rooms 201, 202, 203 and 208. The center will also have access to the gym, however, the space was not used to determine capacity.

Room 201 measures 27ft. by 25 ft. (675) square feet. This space accommodates a capacity of 16 [reduced from 19] children age 30 months to four years.

Room 202 measures 19.6 ft. x 25.6ft. (502) square feet. This space will accommodate a capacity of 10 toddlers 16 to 30 months. There are no changes to this space.

Room 203 measures 28.5 ft. x 19.8 ft. (564) square feet. This space will accommodate a maximum of 11 infants, however; the facility only has eight cribs. The capacity will be eight infants age birth to 16 months. This is an increase from six to eight infants.

Room 208 measures 30.8ft. x 30 ft. (924) square feet, minus 10ft. x 11.8 ft (1180 square feet or (806) square feet. This space will accommodate a capacity of 23



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preschoolers age three to six years. This is a change in age range from 44 months to 60 months. There is no change in capacity to room 208.

The gym measures 62 ft. x 34 ft. or 2,108 square feet. The gym will be utilized for large motor activities during inclement weather and will accommodate the capacity of this facility.

Equipment: The classrooms are furnished and equipped with a variety of age and developmentally appropriate equipment. The equipment is sufficient to support the requested capacity of 57 children, infant to preschool.

Number of sinks and toilets: Rooms 201 and 202 each have one handwashing sink and one toilet inside of the classroom. Room 203 has one handwashing sink and one sink for food prepping. Room 208 has two handwashing sinks and two toilets inside of the classroom, along with one other handwashing sink. There is a total of five handwashing sinks, one food prep sink and four toilets. This supports the center capacity.

Outdoor play area - location, fenced or not, water hazards: The outdoor play area is completely fenced in. There are two separate fenced-in areas for outdoor play behind the facility. There is an area for infants and toddlers and an area for preschoolers and those who are older. There are no water hazards on the property.

Documentation if a lead hazard risk assessment was required and the results: A lead hazard risk assessment was completed on 09/01/2020. It was determined and documented that there is no lead present.

Documentation of playground safety: A playground inspection was completed on 09/24/2020. The large composite play structure (with a climber and slides), the stepping pods, and balance beam are all approved for ages two to five years. There is also a bike pad, a stage, and a sand box on the property.

B. Program Description. The child care program will offer a full-time program that promotes the High Scope Curriculum that is focused on the following content areas:

Approaches to learning
Social and emotional development
Physical Development and Health
Language, Literacy and Communication
Math



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Creative Arts
Science and Technology
Social Studies

Ages of children served: Ages of children served will be birth to six years old.

Proposed days and hours of operation: Proposed days of operation are Monday through Friday. Proposed hours of operation are 6:30 am to 6:30 pm.

Full or part time (AM or PM sessions or both): This is a full and part time program.

Other program components - transportation, swimming, food service: There are no other program components. The food service will be provided by parents.

Name of program director and under what rules the program director is qualified: The program director and licensee is Kimberly Clark. Ms. Clark has a Bachelor of Arts in Elementary Education with a ZA endorsement along with a Master of Science degree in Education Administration/Leadership. She was approved as a program director on 10/29/2020 under R 400.8113 (7)(b)(9).

Is there a central administrator that meets the administrative requirement?
There is no central administrator for this facility.

Explanation of variance(s), if any: There are no variances for this facility.

C. Rule/Statutory Violations. There are no rule violations for this facility.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that the capacity be reduced from 58 to 57 with an increase of two infants. I recommend that the age range be changed to birth to six years. I recommend no other changes to this child care center.
