Child care staff member David Zinger did not provide appropriate care and supervision on multiple occasions when he put his foot/feet on the backs or legs of children in care to keep them laying flat on their cots for nap time. A list of ideas, recommendations will also be given at the same time that address the citation. Director will have discussion and check for understanding with staff based on citation. R 400.8179 Program.	Program director Ms. Clark, Ms. Zinger, child care staff member 1 and child care staff member 2 all stated the center uses “pressure points” therapy with the children in care because they have special needs, and it helps calm them. Child A, Child B, and Child C do not have anything in their records that indicated “pressure points” therapy was recommended for the children. Additionally, none of the child care staff members were trained in the proper use of this therapy.	Compliance will be achieved by giving a copy of specific licensing rule and TA explanations to staff members. A list of ideas, recommendations will also be given at the same time that address the citation. Director will have discussion and check for understanding with staff based on citation. R 400.8188 Sleeping, resting, and supervision.	Children in care who choose not to sleep at rest time were not typically given quiet activities. 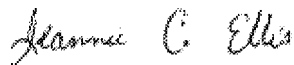
