III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection I observed staff keeping count on white boards in their classrooms. An infant was sleeping in a crib, alone on her back. I observed handwashing, diapering, and sanitizing. I observed staff engaged with infants developing their gross motor skills and coordination. I observed free play, small centers supporting literacy skill building. Children played with blocks and worked cooperatively to build a bridge. Worm painting to develop fine motor skills and

outdoor play were observed. I observed snack, and children lining up to transition. Records were readily available, complete and organized.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8112 Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.

**(2) An applicant or licensee shall do all of the following:
(b) Maintain a copy of the completed and signed form or forms for each individual entered into the child care background check system under the license.**

One of eight staff files reviewed did not maintain a copy of the completed and signed form or forms for each individual entered into the child care background check system under the license.

R 400.8520 Interior finishes.

(14) Combustible materials and decorations may be displayed on walls, not to exceed 20% of each wall in each room. Combustible materials and decorations suspended from or near the ceiling are prohibited.

The preschool classrooms contains combustible materials and decorations displayed on walls exceeding 20% of each wall in the room.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular child care license upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan.
