Attached is your renewal inspection report. During the onsite inspection I observed children handwashing, lining up, and transitioning between activities. Children were engaged in free play and guided dramatic play. Literacy activities and fine motor skill building activities with playdoh, and an outdoor activity that the children were able help with developing and promoting their sense of independence were observed. I read a story to the children at their request. I observed parent pick up. The children are engaged with their caregiver. Records were organized and readily available.

- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, a regular license will be issued. You will receive it in the mail.
