

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

When I arrived children in care were outside playing. Children transitioned to indoors and engaged in free choice. The programming was organized and developmentally appropriate for the children in care. Child care staff members worked as a team, engaged with children in care, and used appropriate communication skills. The center has a sufficient amount of developmentally appropriate equipment accessible for children to use.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
