R 400.8170(14)	Shock-absorbing surfacing materials are not required for equipment that requires a child to be standing or sitting on the ground during play.  Technical assistance was provided to LD/PD regarding small house located outside. The small house had a slide attached which was not inspected or approved by a certified playground inspector. The house was removed during inspection. LD/PD understands any equipment that has an elevated playing or climbing surface must meet R 400.8170(11) & (13) prior to use.

<b>Consultation</b>
R 400.8110(10) Consultation was provided to LD/PD regarding office space. LD/PD understands the office space is not approved for children's use. Children are prohibited from being in the office while

ill, waiting for parent pick up, or for any reason. Children must remain in approved rooms with child care staff members that meet all child care licensing requirements to be a child care staff member. LD/PD will train child care staff members, including receptionists and all office staff, ensuring children are in approved child use spaces.
