

### Approved Child Use Space:

The Infant Room accommodates 9 children ages birth-2 1/2 years.

Toddler 1 accommodates 5 children ages birth - 2 1/2 years.

Toddler 2 accommodates 8 children ages birth - 2 1/2 years.

Classroom 1 accommodates 16 children ages 2 1/2 years and older.

Classroom 2 accommodates 18 children ages 2 1/2 years and older. If children ages 2 1/2 - 3 years old are present, the group size must be kept at a maximum of 16 children.

The gym accommodates up to 108 preschool and school aged children.

The nap room accommodates 20 preschool and school aged children.

Total requested capacity: 90 children ages birth thru 12 years old.

The children may be spread out in the above mentioned rooms, as long as there are no more than 90 children present in the center at one time. Each room must also be in compliance with the room capacity, group size requirements, and approved age ranges.

The center does not provide transportation, food service, or swimming.

### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

The center provides the children with a variety of play and learning activities. I provided a rule review regarding the use of volunteers, the staff and volunteer illness exclusion plan, and the center's written emergency procedures. The written emergency procedures must address each type of required emergency and include a plan for how infants and toddlers will be accommodated. A plan for accommodating children with special needs must be included if applicable.

### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
