III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection I observed free choice, outside time, toileting, hand washing, diapering, and lunch. Interactions between child care staff members and children were positive and developmentally appropriate. All classrooms were equipped with an adequate amount of age-appropriate play and learning equipment. Technical assistance was provided on emergency procedures, health and safety refreshers, and placement of adult scissor and plastic bags.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
