This letter is to advise you that the 04/22/2022 corrective action plan you submitted, regarding each rule violation cited in the recently completed Special Investigation Report, is approved.

On 2/15/22, the center did not provide Child A with appropriate care and supervision when Ms. Allison Brooks, child care staff member helped Child A up from her sleeping mat by lifting her by her arms rather than lifting her up from under her arm pits. Child A sustained a nursemaid elbow injury from being lifted by her arms.	I, Ms. Nancy Hunter, licensee designee was found in noncompliance of this licensing rule. I will assure the child care staff members provide the children with appropriate care and supervision at all times. On 2/15/22, Ms. Carrie Brooks did not provide Child A with appropriate care and supervision when she helped up Child A from naptime by lifting her by her arms in lieu of under her arm pits. Child A suffered a nursemaid's	04/22/2022

		<p>elbow injury as a result from being lifted up by her arms. Child A's Mother was notified of the injury and picked up Child A from care and took her to the ER for examination. Child A's elbow was set back by the physician and Child A returned back to care at the center on 2/17/22. Initially, we did not know how Child A injured her arm; however, after hearing she had nursemaids elbow injury, Ms. Brooks confirmed she lifted her from her nap by her arms and not lifting her under the arm pits. Since being made aware of the injury, I reminded all of the child care staff members of the importance to assure they are picking up all of the children correctly by lifting them under their arms pits rather than by lifting them from their arms. In addition, I have also posted pictured diagrams in each classroom to remind the staff members to pick up the children under their arms in lieu of by their arms to avoid any injury. Since the incident, I have spoken with all of the staff members to remind them of the importance of assuring the children are provided with appropriate care and supervision at all times. I reminded the staff members although this injury was accidental, it could have been prevented by lifting Child A correctly. We also discussed the importance of assuring that the child care children are provided with appropriate care and</p>	
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		supervision at all times. This violation has been corrected and will be maintained at all times.
