

The center also operates as a summer day camp program all day during the summer months. During the summer, there are various activities both indoors and outdoors.

The Youth Lounge/After School Room accommodates 21 school-age children. The Gymnasium accommodates the center's total capacity of 105 school-age children. The Small Gym accommodates 23 school-age children.


III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During my on-site inspection I observed drop offs, free play, lining up before outside time, and hand washing before lunch. Interactions between child care staff members and child care children were positive.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
