

Approved Child Use Space:

Mason Consolidated Schools is located in Mason Central Elementary School in Erie, Michigan. Mason Central Elementary School is an active school building serving children grades kindergarten through 5th grades. The center utilizes three rooms as approved child use space: classroom 8, Classroom 9, and the gymnasium for large motor skilled activities. Currently, the center is only utilizing room 9 (GSRP) for preschool children.

The center offers fulltime preschool programming Monday through Thursday from 8:10 am until 3:15 pm through the school year. The center provides breakfast, lunch and snacks for the children that are prepared in a centralized kitchen located in the school building operated by The Nutrition Group. The snacks and meals consist of fresh food and prepackaged food items that are prepared in accordance with the Children and Adult Care Food Program requirements. Transportation is provided by the parents and Mason Consolidated School District.

During my onsite inspection on 11/4/21, I observed the children during mealtime, small and large group activities, reading instruction time, and outdoor activities. All of the rooms were equipped with an adequate amount of age-appropriate play and learning equipment conducive to a preschool setting. The center provides the children with daily various activities that include circle time, name and letter recognition, counting activities, music and reading instruction, and various arts and craft activities. Caregiver interactions with children were positive and nurturing.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8143 Children's records.

(3) For children under school-age, at the time of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain, keep on file, and make accessible in the center 1 of the following:

(a) A certificate of immunization showing a minimum of 1 dose of each immunizing agent specified by the department of health and human services (DHHS).

Two children's records did not contain a certificate of immunization showing a minimum of 1 dose of each immunizing agent specified by the department of health and human services (DHHS) at the time of the child's initial attendance. Ms. McCain will notify the families and have them provide the center with an updated immunization record or a waiver provided by the local health department.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 11/04/2021. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend the issuance of a regular license to the child care center.
