III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection I observed arrival, free choice, large group, story time, snack time, hand washing, diapering, toileting, and outside time. Child care staff

members were engaged with the children and interactions were positive and developmentally appropriate.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8128 Staff; volunteer; tuberculosis.

A center shall keep on file at the center evidence to verify that each child care staff member and each volunteer who has contact with children at least 4 hours per week for more than 2 consecutive weeks is free from communicable tuberculosis (TB). Verification of TB status is required within 1 year before employment or volunteering.

Two out of five child care staff member files did not have evidence to verify they were free from communicable disease (TB).

R 400.8380 Maintenance of premises.

(1) The premises must be maintained in a clean and safe condition and must not pose a threat to health or safety.

An unsecured paper cutter was observed on the counter of the hallway and was accessible to children. This poses a threat to the safety of the child care children.

Technical assistance was given on emergency procedures, labeling opened milk cartons, child sized tables in the infant/toddler room, child information cards and placement of adult scissors and trash bags.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
