II. Purpose of Addendum

On 02/08/2023, the licensee designee, Ms. Autumn Hazekamp, submitted a request to add the newly constructed gymnasium to the approved child use space.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license have been modified on 08/27/2004, 09/02/2004, 08/19/2011, 08/11/2016, 05/26/2017, 09/06/2017, 10/26/2017, 07/12/2018, 04/06/2021, 09/22/2021, and 02/13/2023.

Previously Approved Space

Note: 50 square feet per child is required for children between birth and 2 years 6 months and 35 square feet per child is required for children over 2 years 6 months.

- Room 21 – Preschool, 3-5 years, measures at 32 ft x 27 ft for a total of 864 sq ft. with a capacity of 24
- Room 22 - Itty Bitty, 0-1 year, measures at 32 ft x 27 ft for a total of 864 sq ft with a capacity of 12
- Room 23 – Preschool, 3-5 years, measures at 32.9 ft x 26.26 ft for a total of 837 sq ft. with a capacity of 23.
- Room 24- Little sailors, 1-2 year, measures at 32 ft x 27 ft. for a total of 864 sq ft. with a capacity of 12
- Room 25 - Preschool 3-5 years, measures at 31.9 ft x 26.25 ft for a total of 837 sq ft with a capacity of 23
- Room 26- Divers 2-3 years, measures at 31 ft x 26 ft for a total of 806 sq ft with a capacity of 16
- Room 27- Preschool 3-5 years, measures at 31.9 x 26.25 ft for a total of 837 sq ft with a capacity of 23
- Room 28- Voyagers 3-4 years, measures at 31 ft x 26 ft for a total of 806 sq ft with a capacity of 23
- Room 30-lighthouse crew 4-5 years, measures at 31.9 ft x 26.25 ft for a total of 837 sq ft with a capacity of 23

The cafeteria is approved child use space but was not used to determine capacity.

Newly Approved Space

The gymnasium is approved as additional child use space but was not used to determine capacity. The gymnasium measures 65 ft x 90 ft for a total of 5,850 sq ft. This supports a maximum of 117 infants and toddlers or 167 preschool and school-aged children. The licensee designee understands the group size requirements for each age range as well as that, if children of mixed ages are in the same space, the group size and ratio for the youngest child applies.

Each room has a bathroom with a toilet and sink for a total of 9 each. There are additional bathrooms located throughout this portion of the building near the approved childcare space.

All approved areas are furnished with a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment; there is an adequate amount of equipment to support the capacity.

No new inspections were required for this modification.

Terms

The center is approved for a total capacity of 179 children, ages birth through school-age.

Lunch service is provided through the school for children whose parents may not provide a lunch for them, however most of the children that attend the child care bring their own lunch.

Transportation is provided through the school for preschool age children.

A swimming program is not provided at this time.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the addition of the newly constructed gymnasium as additional child use space.
