This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 01/19/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

During my onsite inspection the preschool classroom was transitioning into nap time. The child care staff members were cleaning tables and getting children their blankets for nap. Both child care staff members sat with children as they fell asleep offering back rubs and reassuring words. In the infant room I was able to observe two infants sleeping using safe sleep protocol. There were an additional seven toddlers laying on cots taking naps as well. Two child care staff members were sitting with toddlers, rubbing their backs to help them fall asleep. An additional child care staff member was updating the parent portal app of the children's daily eating and sleeping habits.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8112(1) Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.

(1) Pursuant to sections 5n and 5q of the act, MCL 722.115n and 722.115q, prior to an individual having any unsupervised contact with children, the department shall determine the individual's eligibility to be any of the following:

c) A child care staff member.

During my onsite inspection it was observed that two child care staff members had not been determined eligible by the department.

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(2) Child care staff members shall have training that includes information about prevention of sudden infant death syndrome and use of safe sleep practices before caring for infants and toddlers.

One child care staff member that was caring for infants and toddlers did not have training in the prevention of sudden infant death syndrome and use of safe sleep practices.

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(3) Before caring for children, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall be trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.

One child care staff member who was working directly with children was not training in the prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 02/09/2022. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.
