This letter is a follow-up to the Department’s findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 06/14/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

During the onsite inspection, I observed two groups of children. When I arrived, the toddler and preschool classes were combined playing outside. They were engaging in various activities, including riding bikes, pushing trucks, examining nature, and engaging in imaginative play. Inside the center, I observed two infants being cared for by one staff member. Infants were just waking up when I arrived. I observed diaper changes for both infants and bottle feeding for one. All staff provided appropriate care and supervision of the children.

As a result of the inspection, I did not find any rule or law violations.

During the exit conference, technical assistance/consultation was provided regarding the following:

- Ms. Wiegand and I discussed the re-fingerprinting process, including when staff come from another center and consent and disclosure forms.
- Of 10 child files reviewed, one child information card had not been updated within the past year and one needed to be updated the same day as the inspection.


