## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection, I observed a combined infant/toddler room, an older toddler room, and a preschool room. I observed free play, painting, circle time, toileting and diapering, hand washing, snack, outdoor play, tummy time, and infant feeding. The child care staff members were engaged with the children and appeared to be bonded.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the exit conference, technical assistance/consultation was provided regarding the following:

- The center's policies do not include that supervised volunteers must have a Public Sex Offender Registry clearance prior to having contact with children in care. Ms. Wiegand will add that to the handbook.
- The parent handbook indicates that children do not engage in outdoor play if the temperature is below 30 degrees Fahrenheit. As the expectation is that children go outside daily, Ms. Wiegand will change the handbook to state that children will play outside daily except in extreme weather.
- The center's medication cabinet held medications that are no longer being used. I reminded Ms. Wiegand of the requirement that medications be returned or destroyed when they are no longer needed or are expired.
- I reminded Ms. Wiegand that parents are to complete child information cards and staff are not to fill in any information left blank by parents.
- A latch on a kitchen drawer was broken and the drawer contains plastic bags and boxes with serrated edges. Ms. Wiegand will repair the latch or move the hazardous items.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
