R 400.8188 (6) Sleeping, resting, and supervision.	An infant was placed to sleep on their stomach.	All infants, regardless of whether or not they roll, will be placed to sleep on their backs.	Ongoing
R 400.8188 (11) Sleeping, resting, and supervision.	An infant fell asleep in a bouncer and was not immediately moved to appropriate sleeping equipment.	Ms. Tarske held a meeting to remind staff of this rule. Infants will only sleep in cribs.	Ongoing
R 400.8345 (4) Water supply; plumbing.	The sink in the kitchen started draining slowly in December and wasn't addressed until late January.	Ms. Tarske will contact her landlord immediately when the center has a maintenance issue.	Ongoing
