III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Description of Facility

This child care center is located in the town of North Muskegon.

Approved space (room numbers, sizes, capacity and ages of children for which each room/well-defined space is approved, etc.):

In the upstairs of the child care center is the **Little Dippers Room. Infants and toddlers** will be cared for in this space. This space is made up of a playroom, changing/nap room, and kitchen/eating space. The spaces measure 15.79 ft. x 15.79 ft., 11.17 ft. x 13.83 ft., and 12.92 ft. x 11.17 ft., for a total of 548.12 square feet of child use space. This will accommodate the requested **capacity of 8 children ages birth through 30 months of age.**

In the downstairs of the child care center is the **Big Dippers Room.** Preschool children be cared for in this space. This room measures 10.58 ft. x 15.83 ft. and 32.33 ft. x 10.67 ft., for a total of 512.44 square feet of child use space. This will accommodate the requested **capacity of 12 children ages 30 months and above. This space was not used to determine the center's capacity.**

At this time the child care center does not have a lead caregiver for the Big Dipper Room. Currently, just the Little Dipper Room will operate. Therefore, **the center's total capacity is currently 8.** The licensee understands that once a lead caregiver is hired for the Big Dipper Room, a modification request must be submitted and approved by the department before the Big Dipper Room can be utilized.

Equipment: The child care center has an adequate amount of developmentally appropriate indoor and outdoor equipment to care for children 0-5 years of age.

Number of sinks and toilets: There are 2 toilets and 2 hand washing sinks in the child care center.

Outdoor play area - location, fenced or not, water hazards: On the north side of the building there is a fenced in outdoor child place space.

Documentation if a lead hazard risk assessment was required and the results: This building was built after 1978, so a lead hazard risk assessment was not required.

Documentation of playground safety: The child care does not have playground equipment that requires a playground safety assessment.

B. Program Description

Ages of children served: Children birth through 5 years of age.

Proposed days and hours of operation: Monday through Friday 6:30 am to 5:30 pm.

Full or part time (AM or PM sessions or both): The child care will provide full and part time care to children.

Other program components - transportation, swimming, food service: The center will provide breakfast, lunch and 2 snacks.

There is no transportation or swimming components.

Name of program director and under what rules the program director is qualified: Jennifer Bogue-Courter is approved with a variance under R 400.8113(7)(f).

Is there a central administrator that meets the administrative requirement? No. A central administrator is not required.



I recommend issuance of this child care center.


