## II. Purpose of Addendum

We received a request (updated by interim director Susie Weiner) to approve Room 101 and to increase the center capacity from 115 children to 174

## IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the license were modified on 10/28/04 and 03/07/22.

The following rooms are approved in this synagogue-based center:

- Room 101 is 20 ft. x 26 ft., providing 520 square feet, suitable for 10 children under age 30 months.
- Room 103 is 27 ft. x 20 ft., providing 540 square feet, suitable for 11 children under age 30 months.
- Room 104 is 30 ft. x 20 ft., providing 600 square feet, suitable for 12 children under age 30 months.
- Room 105 is 26 ft. x 30 ft., providing 780 square feet, suitable for 22 children over age 30 months.
- Room 106 is 30 ft. x 26 ft., providing 780 square feet, suitable for 22 children over age 30 months.
- Room 107 is 30 ft. x 26 ft., providing 780 square feet, suitable for 22 children over age 30 months.
- Room 108 is 30 ft. x 25 ft., providing 750 square feet, suitable for 21 children over age 30 months.
- Room 109 is 30 ft. x 20 ft., providing 600 square feet, suitable for 17 children over age 30 months.
- Room 110 is 30 ft., x 20 ft., providing 600 square feet, suitable for 17 children over 30 months.
- Room 111 is 27 ft. x 15 ft., providing 405 square feet, suitable for 12 children over age 30 months.
- Room 112 is 27 ft. x 15 ft., providing 405 square feet, suitable for 8 children under age 30 months.

The gym is approved for use. Since it is a multipurpose room, it was not used to calculate the center capacity.

Environmental health inspections were conducted as needed. A fire inspection was last completed on 11/03/21. The building was constructed prior to 1978 and required a lead risk paint assessment. Lead inspections for all rooms listed in this report were completed and the results were determined to be within acceptable limits during various lead inspections completed on 09/19/16, 10/18/21, and 01/25/22.

Program director and licensee Susie Weiner knows that if there is a group of children with a mixed age range, the ratio requirements are calculated using the age of the youngest child.

The classrooms are supplied with sufficient play items and equipment suitable to meet the developmental needs of children and are in ample supply to accommodate the center capacity. The total square footage in the rooms is sufficient for a center capacity of 174.


A minimum of 12 toilets and 22 handwashing sinks available for children's use, meet the capacity needs.

Hours of operation are from 9:00 a.m. 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Typical full-time and part-time options as of this writing are from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Schedules are flexible.

Children bring their own lunch, depending on the duration of their stay with options for food catered from a licensed establishment on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

## V. Recommendation

Room 101 is approved, the new age range is 1 to 6 years, and the total center capacity has been increased to 174.
