

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8125 Staff; volunteer; requirements.

(4) A licensee shall have a written policy regarding screening and supervision of staff and volunteers, including volunteers who are parents of a child in care. The policy must include a statement that any individual registered on the public sex offender registry (PSOR) is prohibited from having contact with any child in care.

There was no staff screening policy that includes all needs required by the current licensing rules.

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(5) Within 90 days of being hired, or the first day as an unsupervised volunteer, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall complete the following trainings, which may count toward annual professional development hours and are available at MiRegistry:

- (a) Administration of medication.**
- (b) Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions.**
- (c) Building and physical premises safety.**
- (d) Emergency preparedness and response planning.**
- (e) Handling and storage of hazardous materials and appropriate disposal of bio-contaminants.**
- (f) Precautions in transporting children, if applicable.**
- (g) Child development.**

Child care staff members A.B. and K.H. were hired more than 90 days ago and have not yet completed training in topics a-g of this rule. The training is included in Health and Safety Course 1 and Course 2 and available at www.miregistry.org.

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.


(8) An on-going professional development plan must be developed and implemented to include all the training and professional development required by these rules.

There was no professional development plan that includes all training required by current licensing rules.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 05/02/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend renewing the license for two years.
