

Rule Number	Rule
R 400.8152(5)	A child care staff member shall keep all medication out of the reach of children and shall return it to the child's parent or destroy it when the parent determines it is no longer needed or it has expired.
R 400.8335(8)(a)	Containers must be labeled with the date opened.
R 400.8152(4)	Prescription medication must have the pharmacy label indicating the physician's name, child's first and last name, instructions, name and strength of the medication, and must be given according to those instructions.
