### Findings of the Inspection

The purpose of the interim inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for child care Center.

During the on-site inspection, I reviewed children’s records and child care staff members’ records. I observed children in care engaged in a variety of developmentally appropriate activities, including coloring, playing with Legos, dramatic play, and indoor play in the multipurpose room. I observed large group time which included story time. I also observed diapering, toileting, hand washing, meal service, and nap time. The child care staff members’ interactions with the children were positive and nurturing. They were attentive to the children’s needs.

During the interim inspection, licensing consultant Alicia Wiggins found 2 violations. The violations are listed and explained below.
