III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8122 Lead caregiver; qualifications; responsibilities.

(9) Verification of the education, credentials, and experience of each lead caregiver shall be kept on file at the center or at MiRegistry.

Three lead caregivers did not have verification of education and hours of experience on file at the center.

R 400.8152 Medication; administrative procedures.

(4) Prescription medication must have the pharmacy label indicating the physician's name, child's first and last name, instructions, name and strength of the medication, and must be given according to those instructions.

The breathing treatment and epi pen at the center did not have the pharmacy label indicating the physician's name, child's first and last name, instructions, name, and strength of the medication.

R 400.8152 Medication; administrative procedures.

(5) A child care staff member shall keep all medication out of the reach of children and shall return it to the child's parent or destroy it when the parent determines it is no longer needed or it has expired.

The center has expired Tylenol and epi pen.

R 400.8170 Outdoor play area.

(10) An outdoor play area and any equipment located on the center's premises must be maintained in a safe condition and inspected daily before use to ensure that no hazards are present.

The large playground has exposed stakes sticking out of the ground and the bolts in the edging around the play areas are raised.

R 400.8340 Food services and nutrition; provided by parents.

(3) Breast milk, formula, milk, other beverages, and food furnished in a same-day supply must be covered and labeled with the child's first and last name and the date.

Two bottles in the Infant classroom were dated 11/20/22 and 11/23/2022.

R 400.8380 Maintenance of premises.

(1) The premises must be maintained in a clean and safe condition and must not pose a threat to health or safety.

The toilet bolt covers were missing on the toilets in the Pre-k B, Preschool, and Young Preschool.

R 400.8380 Maintenance of premises.

(5) There must be no flaking or deteriorating paint on interior and exterior surfaces or on equipment accessible to children.

There is deteriorating paint on the play equipment outside.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 11/21/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
