Dear Ms. Gryglak,

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 02/15/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

Below are the violations.

R 400.8152 Medication; administrative procedures.

(5) A child care staff member shall keep all medication out of the reach of children and shall return it to the child's parent or destroy it when the parent determines it is no longer needed or it has expired.

A toddler's epi-pen had expired.

R 400.8340 Food services and nutrition; provided by parents.

(3) Breast milk, formula, milk, other beverages, and food furnished in a same-day supply must be covered and labeled with the child's first and last name and the date.

Bottles did not include the child's first and last name or the date.

R 400.8385 Poisonous or toxic materials.

Containers of poisonous or toxic materials must be clearly labeled for easy identification of contents and stored out of reach of children.

The cabinet under the sink contained a jug of bleach and the latch that kept it inaccessible to children was broken.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by March 9, 2022. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

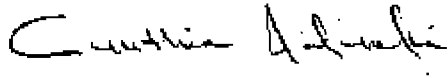
