III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8110 Applicant; licensee; licensee designee; requirements.

(6) The licensee or licensee designee shall maintain accurate records detailing daily arrival and departure times for each child care staff member, child care aide, and volunteer.

The licensee did not maintain accurate records detailing daily arrival and departure times for each child care staff member. On 12/16/2022, three school age staff members did not document arrival or departure times.

R 400.8320 Food preparation.

(5) Ready to eat foods must not be prepared or served using bare hands.

Ready to eat foods were served using bare hands. A staff member in classroom 5 picked up Child A's hotdog and cut it with a knife using her bare hands.

R 400.8380 Maintenance of premises.

(5) There must be no flaking or deteriorating paint on interior and exterior surfaces or on equipment accessible to children.

There was flaking and deteriorating paint on interior surfaces accessible to children. Room 1 and Room 2 had flaking paint on walls in play areas. The toddler room had a train table with deteriorating paint/adhesive.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 12/16/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care license.
