Findings of the Inspection

The renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center [administrative rules](#) and [statutes](#). Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the on-site inspection, I observed children in care engaged in a variety of developmentally appropriate activities, including outdoor play. I also observed toileting, handwashing, and snack time.

The caregivers' interaction with the children was positive and nurturing. They were attentive to the children's needs.

During the renewal inspection, licensing consultant, Alicia Wiggins, found 1 violation. The violation is listed and explained below. An acceptable written corrective action plan was received on 05/08/2024. A regular license will be issued.
