**Findings of the Inspection**

The purpose of the interim inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for child care Center.

During the on-site inspection, I reviewed children’s records and child care staff members’ records. I observed children in care engaged in a variety of developmentally appropriate activities, including dramatic play, playing with blocks and Legos, playing board games and art activities. I also observed toileting, handwashing, and meal service. The child care staff members’ interactions with the children were positive and nurturing.

During the interim inspection, licensing consultant Alicia Wiggins found 4 violations. The violations are listed and explained below. Due to the violations, the licensee/licensee designee must send the bureau a [corrective action plan](#) by 02/01/2024. The corrective action plan may be submitted in the [Child Care Hub Information Record Portal \(CCHIRP\)](#). The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.
