- R 400.8325(1) Sanitization



III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following:

R 400.8113 Program director qualifications; responsibilities.

(9) All program directors shall have at least 2 semester hours or 3.0 CEUs in child care administration or have an administrative credential approved by the department. These semester hours may satisfy a portion of the requirements of subrules (7) and (8) of this rule. The program director may also use 30 hours of administrative training from MiRegistry to meet these requirements.

N.J. did not have two semester hours or 3 CEUs in child care administration.

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(5) Within 90 days of being hired, or the first day as an unsupervised volunteer, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall complete the following trainings, which may count toward annual professional development hours and are available at MiRegistry:

- (a) Administration of medication.**
- (b) Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions.**
- (c) Building and physical premises safety.**
- (d) Emergency preparedness and response planning.**
- (e) Handling and storage of hazardous materials and appropriate disposal of bio-contaminants.**
- (f) Precautions in transporting children, if applicable.**
- (g) Child development.**

Of five staff records reviewed, one staff member (A.G.) had not completed the required training topics indicated in (5)(a-e) and (g).

Note: This training is available in the Health and Safety Course 1 and 2 at www.miRegistry.org or can be obtained with an alternative training source provided it includes the same topics.

R 400.8325 Sanitization.

(1) All tableware, utensils, food contact surfaces, and food service equipment must be thoroughly washed, rinsed,

and sanitized before and after they are used for meals or snacks.

Sanitization methods for food contact surfaces and items children mouth were not always sanitized using a bleach and water solution in the recommended concentration.

Note: The proper level of bleach concentration is between 50-200 ppm. This can be achieved using a ratio of one tablespoon of bleach to one gallon of water. Test strips can verify the strength.

Consultation included: Please mobilize woodchips to ensure ongoing proper depth in fall zones, including swings.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 06/30/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend renewing the license for two years.
