On 10/03/2022, the preschool and preK classrooms were served cheese ball puffs and water as their afternoon snack which does not meet the CACFP requirements, which requires two of the five components to be served. Cheese ball puffs do not meet the requirements to be counted as a grain. Graham crackers and Fruit Loops meet the requirement as a grain but are not served with a 2 nd component, which is required.	The center will provide sufficient nutritional snacks.	10/03/2022

R 400.8122(2)(b) Lead caregivers; qualifications; responsibilities	A lead caregiver is not assigned to the toddler classroom.	A toddler lead caregiver has been hired.	11/07/2022
R 400.8176(13) Sleeping equipment	On 11/03/2022, in the infant classroom, a 3-month-old child and a 7-month-old child were sleeping in their cribs with blankets.	Infants will only sleep in sleep sacks.	10/03/2022
R 400.8380(5) Maintenance of premises.	The toddler classroom had peeling and flaking paint along the area of the wall where the floor molding had been removed. This area was accessible to the children.	New floors and baseboards have been installed.	10/01/2022

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
