Dear Ms. Sherman:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 08/19/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8128 Staff; volunteer; tuberculosis.

A center shall keep on file at the center evidence to verify that each child care staff member and each volunteer who has contact with children at least 4 hours per week for more than 2 consecutive weeks is free from communicable tuberculosis (TB). Verification of TB status is required within 1 year before employment or volunteering.

Four of the CCSM's (G.M, P.L.,A.S., and J.K.) did not have verification of TB status on file.

(3) Before caring for children, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall be trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.

Within 90 days, child care staff members did not complete the following training on Miregistry. Six staff that were hired more than 90 days ago did not complete this training.

(4) Before unsupervised contact with children, all child care staff members who work directly with children shall complete prevention and control of infectious disease training, including immunizations.

Within 90 days, child care staff members did not complete the following training on Miregistry. Six staff that were hired more than 90 days ago did not complete this training.

(3) Staff and volunteers shall ensure that children wash their hands at all of the following times:
(a) before meals, snacks, r food preparation experiences.

Staff did not ensure that children washed their hands prior to having lunch. It was shared by Ms. Sherman that children washed their hands prior to sitting down watching a movie. I observed children sitting down for a movie from 11am to 11:34am at which time they were observed touching their feet and other objects. The children transitioned directly to the lunch table.

(10) When media are used with children 2 years of age and older, all of the following apply:

(e) When media are available for children's use, other activities must also be available to children.

Children (mixed group of toddlers and early preschool) watched television from 11:00 am to 11:34am. I observed three occasions when children were redirected to sit down as they were trying to get up from watching the movie. On one occasion a child walked to a play area and was told to sit back down to watch the movie. I informed Ms. Sherman of this rule and encouraged her to ensure other activities are available for children to engage in during this time.

(16) The depth of the loose-fill surface material must be restored to its required depth when it has moved or becomes otherwise compromised.

Both the preschool and the infant/toddler playground areas were observed with minimal woodchips. This was addressed with Ms. Sherman during the renewal onsite inspection and at the time of this observation Ms. Sherman shared the woodchips had not been replaced.

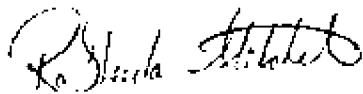
